

Advanced EndNote (KMIR3B)

The EndNote programme offers students and researchers a simple and effective means of managing records and documents. In most cases it is unnecessary to modify the structures that EndNote uses but many journals have specialised styles or requirements that will require some fine tuning. Long documents such as theses or books also require careful management to ensure that references inserted through EndNote conform to what is required.

Advanced EndNote will be particularly useful for anyone undertaking a major project and is not recommended for those who have recently completed an introductory course. After attending you will be able to

- Locate a bibliographic style to suit a specific set of requirements for reference formatting
- Modify an EndNote style or create a new one to conform with editorial requirements
- Use EndNote with long documents made up of chapters or parts
- Solve various EndNote problems

After attending this session you will be able to use EndNote confidently in complex research undertakings. EndNote X3 will be used.
